Essex Redbacks Baseball Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches and administrators associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with either the Head Coach, Team Player Representative or any committee member

As a member of Essex Redbacks Baseball Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable safety equipment – Protective box (and gum shield if preferred for batting) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. Note: Helmets & catching equipment will be provided by the club unless personally purchased equipment is preferred.
- Members must pay any fees including yearly subscriptions, training, game or other fees promptly as determined by the committee and by the dates agreed by the committee.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members must abide by the Club Rules and act within the constitution of the club.
